RE: STUDENT RESOURCE SCHEME 2026

Robertson State School offers families the opportunity to participate and continue in the Student Resource Scheme (SRS). A SRS provides parents with a convenient and cost effective way to obtain and access educational resources that their child needs for school. These resources supplement the school's resources and enhance your child's learning experience. This letter includes important information about the fees and inclusions for the SRS and will assist you in deciding as to whether you wish to participate in the SRS.

The Queensland Government supports your child's education by providing funding for instruction (teachers), facilities (school grounds, buildings, internet) and administration (staff to run the school). Funding for school does not extend to individual resources such as textbooks, equipment for personal use and many other resources used by your child in the classroom, therefore the SRS helps parents to access these resources at Robertson at a minimal cost.

The SRS contribution will purchase the resources as outlined overleaf in the 'direct out of pocket expenses' costing table. We anticipate that for parents to purchase these resources outside of the SRS could cost more than \$1,500.00. We can keep the cost to a minimum due to the school's bulk buying power.

The cost for participation in Robertson's Student Resource Scheme (SRS) for 2026 will be **\$130.00** per student for Prep to Year 6. As part of its support for families, the Queensland Government will provide a **\$100 subsidy** for each primary school student enrolled in Prep to Year 6. This subsidy will go towards covering the cost of essential school resources.

As a result, the cost for families will be reduced to just \$30.00 per student.

An additional SRS fee exists for music students. Those students who are selected to join the choir and instrumental programs will be invoiced in February after their acceptance into the program is confirmed by the Instrumental Coordinator.

The music SRS fees for 2026 will be:

Choir Pocovoci Years 2-3	\$20.00
Choir Cantabile years 4-6	\$50.00
Instrumental music levy and charges	\$76.00
Instrumental hire fee	\$150.00

Please note that costs relating to excursions, incursions, camps, interschool sport, competitions, swimming and Year 6 graduation are all outside of the SRS.

With regards to the SRS agreement, this agreement commenced in 2020 and stands for the duration of your child's enrolment with Robertson State School. The agreement is provided at the time of enrolment at Robertson SS. If you would like to participate, but are experiencing financial difficulties, please contact the school to arrange an appointment to discuss options. Any information that you provide will be confidential

The school will email the invoice for payment shortly which includes **BPOINT** details. Payments can be made **BPOINT** and **EFTPOS (Credit/Debit Card)**.

When paying by **BPOINT**, please use the Customer Reference Number (**CRN**) and invoice number printed on the invoice received from the school. If unsure of your CRN, please contact the school.
