This funding will be used to

- Develop a deep understanding of the Australian Curriculum through refining planning, assessing and moderating processes
- Develop Science and English localised units to responding to students learning needs
- Collaboratively develop whole school strategies to support and sustain staff and student wellbeing
- 100% of teachers receive professional development and coaching in the Australian Curriculum
- 98% of students above National Minimum Standards (NMS) in NAPLAN Reading, Writing, and Numeracy and at or above a "C" in English
- 5% improvement in the Upper Two Bands (U2B) in NAPLAN and 5% improvement in A/Bs in English and Mathematics (semester data)
- 5% improvement in wellbeing indicators in the School Opinion Survey

Our initiatives include

- Develop leadership and class teacher capability in using the Australian Curriculum
- Develop individual teachers and year level teaching teams capability through coaching
- Accelerate students' literacy through differentiation and inclusion
- Develop a wellbeing action plan for staff and introduce Zones of Regulation in classrooms for students

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Rewriting the Australian Curriculum to be responsive to our students' learning needs and context
- Monitoring the performance of students through the triangulation of data and targeted teaching
- Providing individual and group learning support and enrichment to those students below benchmark, those students requiring adjustments and those students in the Upper Two Bands
- Implementing a Wellbeing Action Plan for staff and Zones of Regulation for students
