iPad Program Parent Checklist

To help prepare for the BYO iPad Program in 2019 please use the checklist below.
☐ Ensure your child's iPad meets the minimum recommended specifications as
outlined on the school's iPad Portal (iPad Portal).
☐ Discuss Acceptable Device Use with your child which can be found in the General
Information document on the school's iPad Portal.
$\ \square$ Ensure that your child understands they are NOT to share their iPad with other
students.
$\ \square$ Ensure that your child understands that they are not to capture photo, video or
audio unless advised to do so by their class teacher.
☐ Ensure that your child understands that if their regular teacher is away, the iPads
may be not be used that day.
$\ \square$ Purchase a protective cover for your child's iPad and considered a tempered glass
screen protector and water resistant carry bag sleeve.
$\hfill\square$ Load the required apps on your child's iPad as per the year level iPad app lists
which can be found on the school's iPad Portal.
$\hfill\square$ Capture holiday photos for the beginning of the year on your child's iPad if
requested to do so by the class teacher.
$\hfill\square$ Apps may request a user name and password to be created, there is no need to do
so unless requested by your child's class teacher.
$\ \square$ Delete old photos and unused apps as they take up too much space.
$\hfill \square$ No social media accounts on the iPads, many of these sites have age restrictions
(13+).
$\hfill\square$ Delete your personal email, apps and unlink accounts – don't need access to your
personal details on their school iPads.
$\hfill \Box$ Set up a passcode to open their iPad that your child knows, and make sure they
know not to tell anyone else this password.
$\hfill\square$ Name their iPad (in Settings-General-About-Name) – use their first name and
initial. This makes it easier for their teacher to send them resources.
